

Pitch to the Panel

How to Apply

Only one application can be made per organisation and will only be accepted via www.thegoodexchange.com. This must be live on the portal by Thursday 9th April. Although, the sooner you apply the more time you will have to start fundraising. You may enter an existing project on The Good Exchange providing it meets the criteria below and has not already received a grant from Greenham Trust (excepting Trust Top Up).

After your on-line submission, send an email to events@greenhamtrust.com, include in the title 'Pitch to the Panel' and quote your application number.

You are required to:

1. Provide a short synopsis of your project (100 words maximum), and
2. An image we can use to illustrate your project on the website, social media etc if successful.

At the beginning of May, up to six applicants will be shortlisted and asked to present a live five minute presentation at the Pitch to the Panel event.

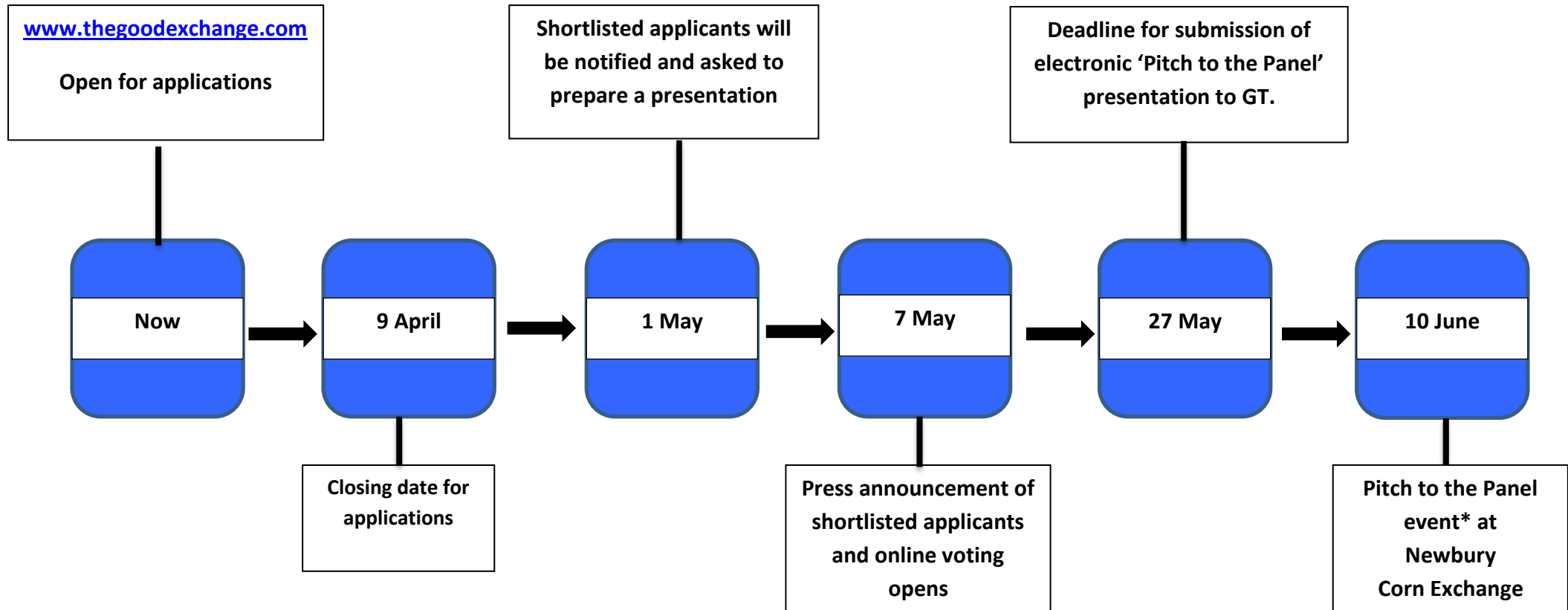
Terms and Conditions

- Projects must be for charitable purposes and the amount sought should be between £30,000 and £100,000.
- Applications are limited to one per organisation;
- Projects must be for the benefit of people in West Berkshire and the following wards of north Hampshire: East Woodhay, Burghclere, Highclere & St Mary Bourne, Kingsclere, Tadley Central, Tadley South, Baughurst & Tadley North and Pamber & Silchester.
- Projects should be for capital items, provision of a groundbreaking new service or significant enhancement to an existing service but not core funding for existing services.
- The closing date for applications is Thursday 9 April 2020.
- Previous applicants may be considered for new projects.
- Applicants are encouraged to start fundraising for their project via The Good Exchange as soon as possible as this will demonstrate support for the cause to the panel.
- Successful applicants will be asked to sign the full Terms and Conditions of grant aid.
- Projects need to be completed by 30 June 2021.
- The grant will only be paid once Greenham Trust (GT) receives confirmation that the balance of funds has been raised and the project is going ahead.
- The applicant shall cooperate fully with GT regarding publicity.
- The judges' decision is final and GT reserves the right to withdraw grant aid.

* Following each presentation there will be a question and answer session with the Panel of up to 5 minutes duration.

- After the presentations the audience will be invited to vote (via mobile phone) for their preferred project.
- Each vote represents a donation of £1.00 of “public top up” which will be provided by Greenham Trust.
- Online votes from the public, (7/5/20 to 8/6/20 inclusive), will attract a £1 donation by Greenham Trust up to an overall maximum of £5,000.
- After the audience has voted, the Panel will award £100,000 to their chosen project or projects.
- Applications which are successful on Pitch to the Panel will remain on thegoodexchange.com for 12 months, however will not be considered for a community grant in Autumn 2020. They will be eligible for online donations and grants from the public and other funders.
- Applications not shortlisted for Pitch to the Panel will remain on thegoodexchange.com for 12 months and will be eligible for public donations and consideration by Greenham Trust and other registered funders.
